




- 1) Mapex manufactures Pro M, M and V shells from select laminations of North American Maple and Bass wood hardwoods.
- 2) The laminated plies are molded to shape with technical precision under computer monitored heat and pressure.
- **3)** After being inspected for surface flaws, shells designated for 'Transparent' finishes, receive the first of several hand-applied coats of stain.
- 4) Polished Black and other solid colors also receive several layers of hand applied opaque finish.
- **5)** Our new "IceTM" finish combines a mechanically-applied base finish with computer controlled 'burst' color sprays. Followed by hand finishing and polishing.
- **6)** All lacquered shells are cured to exact specifications in Mapex own computer controlled microwave process rooms.
- **7)** Consistently accurate bearing edges are assured from the very beginning with computer directed, mechanical cutting lathes.
- **8-9)** Computer controllers guide uniquely designed bearing edge polishing machines and then each shell receives hand buffing and bearing edge treatment.
- **10-11)** Each shell receives high-speed application of jewelers rouge and then speical hand polishing wheels to bring out the highlights in their hardened finishes.
- **12)** Final assembly returns to the skilled craftsman for tuning, final adjustment and packaging.





In addition to a wide range of drumset configurations. the Pro M series includes a wide range of available component pieces, the Pro M, as with all Mapex shells have an exclusive limited-lifetime warranty.






I.T.S. Isolated **Double Tom/Bass Drum Holder**




Mapex M series drums feature a 7-ply interior basswood + 1-ply exterior maple 8.1mm drum shell. The interior basswood shell is a hardwood that has been used extensively in the manufacture of musical instruments drum to its inherent tonal properties and relative affordability. Bassswood is similar to birch in both its appearance and timbre; accentuated high and low frequencies with slightly reduced midrange response. However, bass wood features an additional boost in the lower midrange areas, commonly associated with mahogany. The harmonic result is a tightly grained, full-bodied yet relatively lightweight material that blends perfectly with other hardwoods providing enhanced depth, attack and projection.


